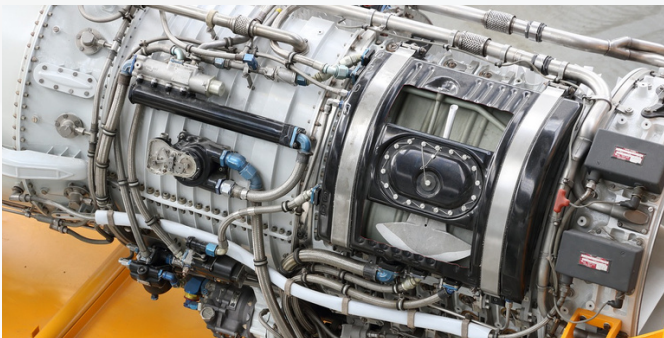

JAPAN – A COUNTRY IN CONSTANT MODERNIZATION

The capital of Hyogo Prefecture, Kobe is one of Japan's principal ports and grew during the period of Japan's modernization. Kobe has a broad spectrum of industrial clusters from heavy industries and SMEs with outstanding technologies and expertise to locally based industries.

Many foreign-affiliated companies as well as research and manufacturing facilities belonging to a number of major Japanese companies in the aerospace industry are located in Hyogo Prefecture.

Japan is developing a green transformation plan, committing JPY 20 trillion (\$150 billion) to drive the mobilization of JPY 150 trillion over the next decade. The initiative targets hydrogen, ammonia, synthetic methane, and synthetic fuels, with a focus on expanding into high-demand overseas markets. The government is also revising its Basic Hydrogen Strategy, aiming to increase hydrogen supply to approximately 12 million tons by 2040 – a sixfold increase.

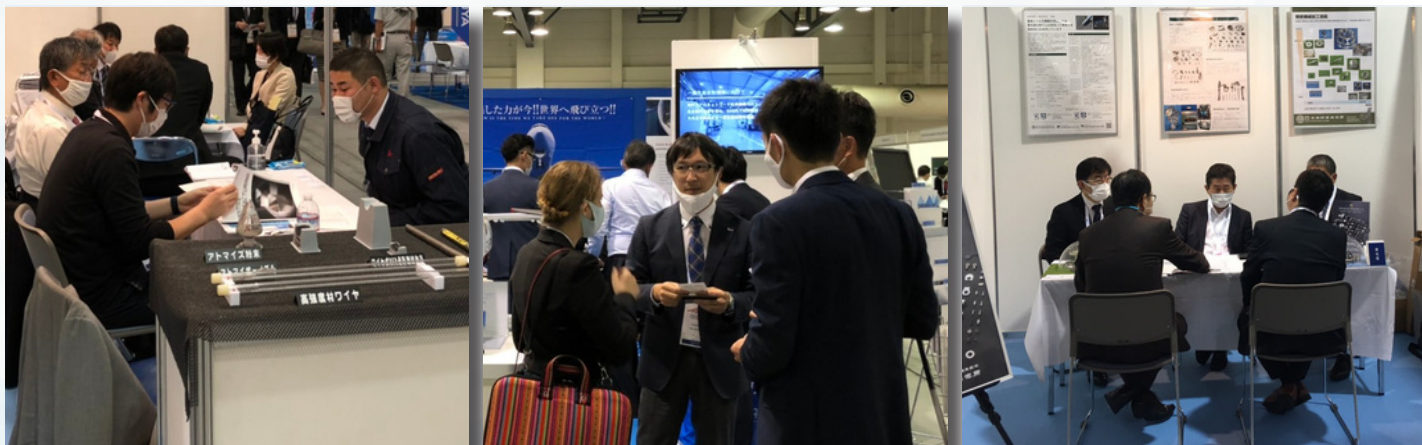
